Term 2 (January-February 2024):

EDUC-5443-A Art and Music Education for the Elementary Classroom (M, W 8:30 AM - 10:20 AM) This course will introduce two elements of the elementary major: Visual Art and Music. Existing curricula in these fields will be examined; students will be given opportunities to plan and present lessons that meaningfully integrate Visual Art and Music into other areas of the elementary curriculum. (Maximum enrolment: 30). **We are looking for an instructor to teach the Visual Art component of the course only.**

EDUC-5443-B Art and Music Education for the Elementary Classroom (T, Th 8:30 AM - 10:20 AM). This course will introduce two elements of the elementary major: Visual Art and Music. Existing curricula in these fields will be examined; students will be given opportunities to plan and present lessons that meaningfully integrate Visual Art and Music into other areas of the elementary curriculum. (Maximum enrolment: 30). **We are looking for an instructor to teach the Visual Art component of the course only.**
